

Faith prayers/confessions to raise the dead

Start in praise and worship of God.

Father You say that we were created for Your, Jesus' and the Holy Ghost's pleasure (Rev. 4:11).

And You say in Proverbs 15:8 that the prayer of the upright is Your delight.

And that without faith it's impossible to please You (Hebrews 11:6)

So thank You, I please You with faith filled prayers now in the Name of Jesus.

Father Your word declares:

1 John 5:14-15

this is the confidence that we have in You, that, if we ask any thing according to Your will, You heareth us:

If we know that You hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we've desired of You.

Mark 11:22-24

Jesus says,
Have faith in God.

For verily whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

Therefore He says unto us, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

Matthew 7:7-8,11

Jesus says:

Ask, and it shall be given; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you:

For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

If ye then, being evil (having sinned in the past but now are righteous through Christ), know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall Your Father (Who has never sinned), which is in heaven, give good things to them that ask Him.

Matthew 21:21-22

Jesus said, If ye have faith, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done.

And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.

Matthew 17:18,20

And Jesus rebuked the devil in the boy; and he departed out of the boy: and the child was cured from that very hour.

And Jesus said unto His disciples.... If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.

Lord You declare that death is an enemy and that freely I've received so I can freely give, and you command me to preach the gospel, heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, cast out devils, and RAISE THE DEAD! (Matthew 10:7-8)

Hebrews 11:1, 6, 35

Now faith is the substance of things hoped for (including the dead raised), the evidence of things not seen (including the dead raised).

But without faith it is impossible to please You: for he that cometh to You must believe that You are, and that You are a rewarder of them that diligently seek You.

And through faith women received their dead raised to life.

I by faith in the Lord Jesus, Who destroyed death and the devil that had in the past the power thereof, and also I by the power of the Holy Ghost, command death and every fallen angel to be thou removed, remove hence to yonder place, and be thou cast into the sea from [Name of dead person] that has died, in the Name of Jesus!!!

Ephesians 1:17-22

I pray that You the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto me the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of You: The eyes of my understanding being enlightened; that i may know what is the hope of my calling, and what the riches of the glory of Your inheritance in the saints,

And know what is the EXCEEDING greatness of Your POWER to us-ward who believe, according to the working of Your mighty power, the same power which You wrought in Christ, when You raised Him from the dead, that power works in us!!!! and set Jesus at Your own right hand in the heavenly places,

Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and also death, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:

And hath put all things under His feet, including death, and gave Him to be the Head over all things to the church, us His Body, Which has the same power to raise the dead, by that power that works in us that raised Christ from the dead also.

Elijah and the widow's son of zarephath

1 Kings 17:17-24

[17]And its come to pass, that this son/daughter of their mother, has fallen sick; and their sickness is so sore, that there is no breath left in them.

[19]And we say, Give me thy son/daughter. And we take them out of the bosom of unbelief, and carry them up into the loft of heavenly places in Christ, and lay them before You Lord.

[20]And we cry unto You LORD, and say, O LORD my God, may this evil not be brought upon this mother, by her son/daughter slain?

[21]And we stretch our selves upon them three times, by faith, and cry unto you LORD, and say, O LORD my God, we pray thee, let this child of Yours, their soul come into them again. (Say 3x) in Jesus Name!

[22]And thank You LORD You hear our voice like You heard the voice of Elijah; and the soul of this [Name] comes into them again, and they revive, in Jesus Name!

[23]And we take this child of Yours, and bring them down out of the chamber and into the house of the Lord, and deliver them unto their mother, brothers and sisters in Christ, and we say like Elijah said, See, they liveth!

[24]And everyone knows by this that we are men and women of God, and that the word of the LORD in our mouth is Truth. And You Lord get all glory, honor, and praise!

2 Kings 4:18-37

Lord like the Shunnamite woman, whose son died, we run and come to Thee and to any men or women of God in our lives, as You say to call for the elders of the church if any is sick among us and the prayer of faith shall save the sick. (James 5:13-16)

[23] and we say like she said, It shall be well, and we

[24] go forward (in Christ),

[25] and when asked like Elisha's servant asked, is it well with [Name]?

26) We answer, It is well (for we walk by faith and not by sight, like Abraham did when he and his wife were dead concerning bearing children. AND before You Whom we believe as he believed, even God, Who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were (and we call [Name] alive in Jesus Name!)

who against hope we believe in hope, according to that which was spoken by You Lord, in the promises of You, that [Name] shall not die but live and declare the works of the Lord!

And being not weak in faith, we consider not [Name] body now dead, And we stagger not at the promises of You through unbelief; but are strong in faith, giving glory to You God;

And being fully persuaded that, what You have promised, You are able also to perform.

[27] and Lord though our soul may be vexed within us because of this situation and death, we grab a hold of You.

[[29] thank You Lord we Gird up our loins with the belt of Truth, and take the staff of Your Word, do not get distracted by other people and things and words of unbelief, and we lay the staff of Your Word upon this person....

"They are HEALED BY CHRIST'S STRIPES!!!"

[31] and though they might not awake right away, as the Shunnamite woman's child didn't when the staff was laid on him,

[33] we go into deep prayer unto You LORD and

[34] we go and lay upon this person, whether in person or in spirit, by faith, and put our mouth upon their mouth, and our eyes upon their eyes, and our hands upon their hands: and we stretch ourselves upon this person and lay down our lives for them; and the flesh of them waxes warm.

[35] Then we return, and walk to and fro; and go up, and stretch ourselves upon them: and they sneeze seven times, and they open their eyes.

[36] and we call up the family and say "Take up [Name]."

[37] Then go they in, and fall at Your feet, and bow themselves to the ground, and take up their formerly dead person.

2 Kings 13:20-21

[20] thank You Lord that when the dead touches us, they revive, and stand up on their feet, like the dead man thrown on Elisha's bones stood up when he touched his bones.

Luke 7:11-17

Behold there is this dead person (Name) carried out,

[13] And when we see the family we have compassion on them, and say unto them, Weep not.

[14] And we come and touch the bier: and they that bare the dead, stand still. And we say, (Name), I say unto thee, Arise in Jesus Name!!

[15] And they that are dead sit up, and begin to speak. And they are delivered to their loved ones.

[16]And there comes a fear on all: and they glorify God, saying, That Jesus is risen; and, That God hath visited his people.

[17]And this rumour of Jesus raising the dead goes forth throughout all the region round about.

Mark 5:22-23,35-42

[22] Lord, like Jairus, we fall at Your feet,

[23]And beseech You greatly, saying, [Name] lieth at the point of death: I pray thee, come and lay Thy hands on them, that they may be healed; and they shall live.

[35] help us Lord not to listen to those that say, "This person is dead: why troublest thou the Master any further?"

[36]As soon as we hear those words that are spoken to us or our minds, we say like Jesus, "Be not afraid, only believe."

[37]And we suffer no man not in faith to follow us, save only those in faith

[38]And we come to the place where they sleep and may see tumult and people wailing greatly.

[39]And when we are come in, we say unto them, Why make ye this ado, and weep? [Name] is not dead, but sleepeth.

[40]And they may laugh us to scorn. But thank You Lord we put them all out, and we take those with us in faith, and we enter in where they are lying.

[41]And we take [Name]] by the hand, and say unto them, "[Name], I say unto thee, ARISE!"

[42]And straightway they arise, and walk; And the people are astonished with a great astonishment.

John 11:1,3-4,11,17,22-23,25-27,39-45

[1]Now a certain person is sick, named (Name),

[3]Therefore we send unto Jesus, saying, Lord, behold, they whom thou lovest is sick.

[4] and Jesus says to us, This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God might be glorified thereby.

[11] Our friend sleepeth; but we go, that we may awake them out of sleep.

(17) and though they might be in the grave for a number of days

[22]But we know, that even now, whatsoever we wilt ask of God, God will give it us. So we ask and thank You Father, for raising up physically and bringing back to life (Name).

[23] we say that [Name] shall rise again.

[25]Jesus says unto us, "I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in Me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:

[26]And whosoever liveth and believeth in Me shall never die. Believest thou this? "

[27]we saith unto You, "Yea, Lord: We believe that Thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world."

[39]we say, Take ye away the grave stone and the Spirit of God makes this mountain of death a plain and we bring forth the headstone/death to death thereof crying Grace, Grace unto it." And it doesn't matter how long they've been dead as lazarus was dead four days for

[40]Jesus says unto us, "Said I not unto thee, that, if thou wouldest believe, thou shouldest see the glory of God? "

So we believe and thank You Lord we shall see the glory of God in [Name] raised from the dead!!

[41] and we take away the stone from the place where the dead is laid. And we lift up our eyes to the hills from whence comes our help, and say, "Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me.

[42]And I know that thou hearest me always: but because of the people which stand by I say it, that they may believe that thou hast sent Jesus".

[43]And when we thus have spoken, we cry with a loud voice, "[Name], come forth"

[44]And they that are dead come forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and their face bound about with a napkin. And we say unto those that stand by, "Loose them, and let them go."

[45]Then many of the people which see and hear of the things which Jesus did, believe on Him.

Matthew 27:50-54

[50]Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up the ghost.

[51]And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent;

[52]And the graves were opened, including to [Name]; and many bodies of the saints, including [Name] body, which sleeps arises,

[53]And comes out of the graves after Jesus' resurrection, and goes into the city, and appears unto many.

[54] and when people see the things that are done, they fear greatly, saying, Truly Jesus is the Son of God.

Acts 9:36-42

[37] it's come to pass, like with dorcas, in these days, that [Name] is sick, and died: whom when they had washed, they laid them in a certain place.

[38]And like Peter was called, we call for the elders of the church and When they are come, they are brought into the place where the dead lay, [40] and we put those not in faith out and kneel down, and pray; and turning to the body say, "[Name], arise in Jesus Name." And they open their eyes: and when they see us they sit up.

[41]And we give them our hand, and lift them up, and when we call the saints and widows, present them alive.

[42]And it is known throughout all the world; and many believe in the Lord.

Acts 20:9-12

[9]And like Eutychus who was taken up dead, [Name] has been taken up dead.

[10] But we like Paul, go down, and fall on them, and embracing them say, "Trouble not yourselves; for their life is in them."

[11] and we go about in the work of the Lord, leaving them in hands of God Who raises the dead,

[12]And they are brought up alive, and everyone is greatly comforted.

SO THANK YOU LORD, FOR YOUR GLORY HONOR AND PRAISE, AND TO COMFORT, AND TO EDIFY AND BUILD THE FAITH OF THE SAINTS, AND TO CAUSE THE WORLD TO FEAR AND BELIEVE ON YOU, [NAME] IS RAISED FROM THE DEAD....
