The LORD is gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy.

Psalms 103:8

The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy.

Proverbs 15:1

A soft answer turneth away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger.

Proverbs 15:18

A wrathful man stirreth up strife: but he that is slow to anger appeaseth strife.

Proverbs 16:32

He that is slow to anger is better than the mighty; and he that ruleth his spirit than he that taketh a city.

Proverbs 19:11

The discretion of a man deferreth his anger; and it is his glory to pass over a transgression.

Proverbs 20:2

The fear of a king is as the roaring of a lion: whoso provoketh him to anger sinneth against his own soul.

Proverbs 21:14

A gift in secret pacifieth anger: and a reward in the bosom strong wrath.

Proverbs 22:8

He that soweth iniquity shall reap vanity: and the rod of his anger shall fail.

Proverbs 27:4

Wrath is cruel, and anger is outrageous; but who is able to stand before envy?

Ecclesiastes 7:9

Be not hasty in thy spirit to be angry: for anger resteth in the bosom of fools.

Proverbs 14:17

He that is soon angry dealeth foolishly: and a man of wicked devices is hated.

Proverbs 21:19

It is better to dwell in the wilderness, than with a contentious and an angry woman.

Proverbs 22:24

Make no friendship with an angry man; and with a furious man thou shalt not go: Make no friendship with an angry man; and with a furious man thou shalt not go:

Proverbs 25:23

The north wind driveth away rain: so doth an angry countenance a backbiting tongue.

Amos 1:11

Thus saith the LORD; For three transgressions of Edom, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof; because he did pursue his brother with the sword, and did cast off all pity, and his anger did tear perpetually, and he kept his wrath for ever:

Proverbs 29:22

An angry man stirreth up strife, and a furious man aboundeth in transgression.

Daniel 9:16

O Lord, according to all thy righteousness, I beseech thee, let thine anger and thy fury be turned away from thy city Jerusalem, thy holy mountain: because for our sins, and for the iniquities of our fathers, Jerusalem and thy people are become a reproach to all that are about us.

Daniel 11:20

Then shall stand up in his estate a raiser of taxes in the glory of the kingdom: but within few days he shall be destroyed, neither in anger, nor in battle.

Psalms 7:11

God judgeth the righteous, and God is angry with the wicked every day.

Psalms 2:11 – 12

Serve the LORD with fear,
and rejoice with trembling.

Kiss the Son, lest he be
angry, and ye perish from
the way, when his wrath is
kindled but a little. Blessed
are all they that put their
trust in him.

Psalms 76:7

Thou, even thou, art to be
feared: and who may stand
in thy sight when once thou
art angry?

Psalms 79:5

How long, LORD? wilt thou
be angry for ever? shall thy
jealousy burn like fire?

Psalms 80:4

O LORD God of hosts, how
long wilt thou be angry
against the prayer of thy
people?

Psalms 85:4

Turn us, O God of our
salvation, and cause thine
anger toward us to cease.

Psalms 106:32

They angered him also at the
waters of strife, so that it
went ill with Moses for their
sakes: Because they
provoked his spirit, so that
he spake unadvisedly with
his lips.

Psalms 6:1

(To the chief Musician on
Neginoth upon Sheminith, A
Psalm of David.) O LORD,
rebuke me not in thine
anger, neither chasten me in
thy hot displeasure.

Psalms 7:6

Arise, O LORD, in thine
anger, lift up thyself because
of the rage of mine enemies:
and awake for me to the
judgment that thou hast
commanded.

Colossians 3:8

But now ye also put off all
these; anger, wrath, malice,
blasphemy, filthy
communication out of your
mouth.

Colossians 3:21

Fathers, provoke not your children to anger, lest they be discouraged.

Micah 5:15

And I will execute vengeance in anger and fury upon the heathen, such as they have not heard.

Micah 7:18

Who is a God like unto thee, that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? he retaineth not his anger for ever, because he delighteth in mercy.

Mark 3:5

And when he had looked round about on them with anger, being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, he saith unto the man, **Stretch forth thine hand.** And he stretched it out: and his hand was restored whole as the other.

Zechariah 10:3

Mine anger was kindled against the shepherds, and I punished the goats: for the LORD of hosts hath visited his flock the house of Judah, and hath made them as his goodly horse in the battle.

Zephaniah 2:2

Before the decree bring forth, before the day pass as the chaff, before the fierce anger of the LORD come upon you, before the day of the LORD'S anger come upon you.

Zephaniah 2:3

Seek ye the LORD, all ye meek of the earth, which have wrought his judgment; seek righteousness, seek meekness: it may be ye shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger.

Zephaniah 3:8

Therefore wait ye upon me,
saith the LORD, until the
day that I rise up to the prey:
for my determination is to
gather the nations, that I
may assemble the kingdoms,
to pour upon them mine
indignation, even all my
fierce anger: for all the earth
shall be devoured with the
fire of my jealousy.

Joel 2:13

And rend your heart, and
not your garments, and turn
unto the LORD your God:
for he is gracious and
merciful, slow to anger, and
of great kindness, and
repenteth him of the evil.

Joel 2:14

Who knoweth if he will
return and repent, and leave
a blessing behind him; even
a meat offering and a drink
offering unto the LORD your
God?

Jonah 3:9

Who can tell if God will turn
and repent, and turn away
from his fierce anger, that
we perish not?

Jonah 4:2

And he prayed unto the
LORD, and said, I pray thee,
O LORD, was not this my
saying, when I was yet in my
country? Therefore I fled
before unto Tarshish: for I
knew that thou art a
gracious God, and merciful,
slow to anger, and of great
kindness, and repentest thee
of the evil.

Romans 10:19

But I say, Did not Israel
know? First Moses saith, I
will provoke you to jealousy
by them that are no people,
and by a foolish nation I will
anger you.

Ephesians 4:6

One God and Father of all,
who is above all, and
through all, and in you all.

Habakkuk 3:8

Was the LORD displeased
against the rivers? was thine
anger against the rivers? was
thy wrath against the sea,
that thou didst ride upon
thine horses and thy chariots
of salvation?

Habakkuk 3:12

Thou didst march through
the land in indignation, thou
didst thresh the heathen in
anger.

Nahum 1:3

The LORD is slow to anger,
and great in power, and will
not at all acquit the wicked:
the LORD hath his way in
the whirlwind and in the
storm, and the clouds are
the dust of his feet.

Nahum 1:6

Who can stand before his
indignation? and who can
abide in the fierceness of his
anger? his fury is poured out
like fire, and the rocks are
thrown down by him.

Titus 1:7

For a bishop must be
blameless, as the steward of
God; not selfwilled, not soon
angry, not given to wine, no
striker, not given to filthy
lucre; But a lover of
hospitality, a lover of good
men, sober, just, holy,
temperate;

Revelation 11:18

And the nations were angry,
and thy wrath is come, and
the time of the dead, that
they should be judged, and
that thou shouldst give
reward unto thy servants the
prophets, and to the saints,
and them that fear thy
name, small and great; and
shouldst destroy them
which destroy the earth.

Jeremiah 44:6

Wherefore my fury and mine
anger was poured forth, and
was kindled in the cities of
Judah and in the streets of
Jerusalem; and they are
wasted and desolate, as at
this day.

Jeremiah 49:37

For I will cause Elam to be dismayed before their enemies, and before them that seek their life: and I will bring evil upon them, even my fierce anger, saith the LORD; and I will send the sword after them, till I have consumed them: And I will set my throne in Elam, and will destroy from thence the king and the princes, saith the LORD.

Jeremiah 51:45

My people, go ye out of the midst of her, and deliver ye every man his soul from the fierce anger of the LORD.

Jeremiah 52:3

For through the anger of the LORD it came to pass in Jerusalem and Judah, till he had cast them out from his presence, that Zedekiah rebelled against the king of Babylon.

Jeremiah 11:17

For the LORD of hosts, that planted thee, hath pronounced evil against thee, for the evil of the house of Israel and of the house of Judah, which they have done against themselves to provoke me to anger in offering incense unto Baal.

1 Kings 16:2

Forasmuch as I exalted thee out of the dust, and made thee prince over my people Israel; and thou hast walked in the way of Jeroboam, and hast made my people Israel to sin, to provoke me to anger with their sins;

1 Kings 16:7

And also by the hand of the prophet Jehu the son of Hanani came the word of the LORD against Baasha, and against his house, even for all the evil that he did in the sight of the LORD, in provoking him to anger with the work of his hands, in being like the house of

Jeroboam; and because he killed him.

1 Kings 14:9

But hast done evil above all that were before thee: for thou hast gone and made thee other gods, and molten images, to provoke me to anger, and hast cast me behind thy back: Therefore, behold, I will bring evil upon the house of Jeroboam, and will cut off from Jeroboam him that pisseth against the wall, and him that is shut up and left in Israel, and will take away the remnant of the house of Jeroboam, as a man taketh away dung, till it be all gone.

1 Kings 14:15

For the LORD shall smite Israel, as a reed is shaken in the water, and he shall root up Israel out of this good land, which he gave to their fathers, and shall scatter them beyond the river, because they have made

their groves, provoking the LORD to anger.

1 Kings 15:30

Because of the sins of Jeroboam which he sinned, and which he made Israel sin, by his provocation wherewith he provoked the LORD God of Israel to anger.

1 Kings 22:53

For he served Baal, and worshipped him, and provoked to anger the LORD God of Israel, according to all that his father had done.

Ezekiel 5:15

So it shall be a reproach and a taunt, an instruction and an astonishment unto the nations that are round about thee, when I shall execute judgments in thee in anger and in fury and in furious rebukes. I the LORD have spoken it.

Ezekiel 7:3

Now is the end come upon thee, and I will send mine anger upon thee, and will judge thee according to thy ways, and will recompense upon thee all thine abominations.

Ezekiel 7:8

Now will I shortly pour out my fury upon thee, and accomplish mine anger upon thee: and I will judge thee according to thy ways, and will recompense thee for all thine abominations.

Ezekiel 8:17

Then he said unto me, Hast thou seen this, O son of man? Is it a light thing to the house of Judah that they commit the abominations which they commit here? for they have filled the land with violence, and have returned to provoke me to anger: and, lo, they put the branch to their nose.

Ezekiel 13:13

Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; I will even rend it with a stormy wind in my fury; and there shall be an overflowing shower in mine anger, and great hailstones in my fury to consume it.

Ezekiel 16:26

Thou hast also committed fornication with the Egyptians thy neighbours, great of flesh; and hast increased thy whoredoms, to provoke me to anger.

Ezekiel 20:21

Notwithstanding the children rebelled against me: they walked not in my statutes, neither kept my judgments to do them, which if a man do, he shall even live in them; they polluted my sabbaths: then I said, I would pour out my fury upon them, to accomplish my anger against them in the wilderness.

Ezekiel 22:20

As they gather silver, and brass, and iron, and lead, and tin, into the midst of the furnace, to blow the fire upon it, to melt it; so will I gather you in mine anger and in my fury, and I will leave you there, and melt you.

Ezekiel 25:14

And I will lay my vengeance upon Edom by the hand of my people Israel: and they shall do in Edom according to mine anger and according to my fury; and they shall know my vengeance, saith the Lord GOD.

Ezekiel 35:11

Therefore, as I live, saith the Lord GOD, I will even do according to thine anger, and according to thine envy which thou hast used out of thy hatred against them; and I will make myself known among them, when I have judged thee.

Ezekiel 43:8

In their setting of their threshold by my thresholds, and their post by my posts, and the wall between me and them, they have even defiled my holy name by their abominations that they have committed: wherefore I have consumed them in mine anger.

Hosea 8:5

Thy calf, O Samaria, hath cast thee off; mine anger is kindled against them: how long will it be ere they attain to innocency?

Hosea 11:9

I will not execute the fierceness of mine anger, I will not return to destroy Ephraim: for I am God, and not man; the Holy One in the midst of thee: and I will not enter into the city.

Hosea 12:14
Ephraim provoked him to
anger most bitterly:
therefore shall he leave his
blood upon him, and his
reproach shall his Lord
return unto him.

Hosea 13:11
I gave thee a king in mine
anger, and took him away in
my wrath.

Hosea 14:4
I will heal their backsliding,
I will love them freely: for
mine anger is turned away
from him.

Isaiah 1:4
Ah sinful nation, a people
laden with iniquity, a seed of
evildoers, children that are
corrupters: they have
forsaken the LORD, they
have provoked the Holy One
of Israel unto anger, they are
gone away backward.
