

Matthew 5:27 - **Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not commit adultery:**

Matthew 5:28 - **But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.**

1 John 3:2 - And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.

Galatians 6:7 - Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

Proverbs 15:9 - The way of the wicked is an abomination unto the LORD: but he loveth him that followeth after righteousness.

Psalms 37:4 - Delight thyself also in the LORD; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.

James 1:17 - Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

Psalms 128:3 - Thy wife shall be as a fruitful vine by the sides of thine house: thy children like olive plants round about thy table.

Psalms 128:4

Behold, that thus shall the man be blessed that feareth the LORD.

Proverbs 16:16 - How much better is it to get wisdom than gold! and to get understanding rather to be chosen than silver!

Proverbs 22:4 - By humility and the fear of the LORD are riches, and honour, and life.

Proverbs 18:22 - Whoso findeth a wife findeth a good thing, and obtaineth favour of the LORD.

Proverbs 18:21 - Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

Matthew 8:26 - And he saith unto them, **Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith?** Then he arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm.

Psalms 119:115 - Depart from me, ye evildoers: for I will keep the commandments of my God.

Proverbs 19:14 - House and riches are the inheritance of fathers: and a prudent wife is from the LORD.

Psalms 37:5 - Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass.

Psalms 71:1 - In thee, O LORD, do I put my trust: let me never be put to confusion.

Ecclesiastes 9:9 - Live joyfully with the wife whom thou lovest all the days of the life of thy vanity, which he hath given thee under the sun, all the days of thy vanity: for that is thy portion in this life, and in thy labour which thou takest under the sun.

Ecclesiastes 9:10 - Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do it with thy might; for there is no work, nor device, nor knowledge, nor wisdom, in the grave, whither thou goest.

John 8:11 - She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, **Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.**

1 Corinthians 7:2 - Nevertheless, to avoid fornication, let every man have his own wife, and let every woman have her own husband.

1 Corinthians 7:3 - Let the husband render unto the wife due benevolence: and likewise also the wife unto the husband.

1 Corinthians 7:2 - Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.

Hosea 4:6 - My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge.

Ephesians 5:23 - For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.

Ephesians 5:28 - So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife loveth himself.

Ephesians 5:31 - For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh.

Ephesians 5:33 - Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she reverence her husband.

Psalms 124:8 - Our help is in the name of the LORD, who made heaven and earth.

Luke 6:38 - Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.

1 Peter 3:7 - Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered.

1 John 2:16 - For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

1 John 2:17 - And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.

Psalms 34:14 - Depart from evil, and do good; seek peace, and pursue it.

1 Peter 2:11 - Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul;

1 John 3:8 - He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

1 John 3:7 - Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous.

John 15:7 - If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

Proverbs 13:15 - Good understanding giveth favour: but the way of transgressors is hard.

Matthew 11:30 - For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

Exodus 20:14 - Thou shalt not commit adultery.

Mark 10:19 - Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honour thy father and mother.

Mark 10:27 - And Jesus looking upon them saith, With men it is impossible, but not with God: for with God all things are possible.

Mark 11:22 - Have faith in God.

Mark 11:23 - For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

2 Corinthians 5:7 - We walk by faith, not by sight.

Mark 10:11 - Whosoever shall put away his wife, and marry another, committeth adultery against her. And if a woman shall put away her husband, and be married to another, she committeth adultery.

Galatians 5:16 - This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.

Proverbs 12:28 - In the way of righteousness is life; and in the pathway thereof there is no death.

1 Corinthians 6:18 - Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body.

Proverbs 6:32 - But whoso committeth adultery with a woman lacketh understanding: he that doeth it destroyeth his own soul.

Luke 7:23 - Jesus said: Blessed is he, whosoever shall not be offended in me.

2 Timothy 2:22 - Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

Isaiah 56:2 - Blessed is the man that doeth this, and the son of man that layeth hold on it; that keepeth the sabbath from polluting it, and keepeth his hand from doing any evil.

Psalms 119:37 - Turn away mine eyes from beholding vanity; and quicken thou me in thy way.

2 Thessalonians 3:10 - For even when we were with you, this we commanded you, that if any would not work, neither should he eat.

Psalms 101:3 - I will set no wicked thing before mine eyes: I hate the work of them that turn aside; it shall not cleave to me.

Jeremiah 7:6 - If ye oppress not the stranger, the fatherless, and the widow, and shed not innocent blood in this place, neither walk after other gods to your hurt: Then will I cause you to dwell in this place, in the land that I gave to your fathers, for ever and ever.

Ephesians 4:27 - Neither give place to the devil.

Ephesians 5:11 - And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them.

2 Corinthians 2:11 - Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices.

Proverbs 3:5 - Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.

Proverbs 28:26 - He that trusteth in his own heart is a fool: but whoso walketh wisely, he shall be delivered.

Proverbs 3:7 - Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil.

Psalms 119:160 - Thy word is true from the beginning: and every one of thy righteous judgments endureth for ever.

Psalms 35:13 - I humbled my soul with fasting; and my prayer returned into mine own bosom.

Psalms 119:162 - I rejoice at thy word, as one that findeth great spoil.

Proverbs 29:25 - The fear of man bringeth a snare: but whoso putteth his trust in the LORD shall be safe.

Amos 3:3 - Can two walk together, except they be agreed?

Psalms 119:163 - I hate and abhor lying: but thy law do I love.

John 8:34 - Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin.

Isaiah 53:5 - But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

Proverbs 14:26 - In the fear of the LORD is strong confidence: and his children shall have a place of refuge.

Psalms 119:165 - Great peace have they which love thy law: and nothing shall offend them.

Malachi 3:6 - For I am the LORD, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed.

Psalms 25:11 - For thy name's sake, O LORD, pardon mine iniquity; for it is great.

Psalms 25:7 - Remember not the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions: according to thy mercy remember thou me for thy goodness' sake, O LORD.

Psalms 25:18 - Look upon mine affliction and my pain; and forgive all my sins.

Proverbs 23:21 - For the drunkard and the glutton shall come to poverty: and drowsiness shall clothe a man with rags.

John 14:14 - If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.

John 8:34 - Jesus answered them, **Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin.**

Psalms 121:7 - The LORD shall preserve thee from all evil: he shall preserve thy soul.

Psalms 66:18 - If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me: But verily God hath heard me; he hath attended to the voice of my prayer.

1 Corinthians - 13:6 Rejoice not in iniquity, but rejoice in the truth.

Exodus - 32:33 And the LORD said unto Moses, Whosoever hath sinned against me, him will I blot out of my book.

Proverbs - 17:22 A merry heart doeth good like a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones.

Proverbs - 12:1 Whoso loveth instruction loveth knowledge: but he that hateth reproof is brutish.

Hebrews - 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Galatians 3:11 - The just shall live by faith.

Hebrews 11:6 - But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Psalms 26:9 - Gather not my soul with sinners, nor my life with bloody men: In whose hands is mischief, and their right hand is full of bribes. But as for me, I will walk in mine integrity: redeem me, and be merciful unto me.

Genesis 6:8 – 9 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD. These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God.

Psalms 103:11 – 12 For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him. As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us.

Psalms 119:37 - Turn away mine eyes from beholding vanity; and quicken thou me in thy way.

2 Corinthians 10:4 - (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;)

John 8:51 - **Verily, verily, I say unto you, If a man keep my saying, he shall never see death.**

2 Corinthians 10:5 - Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

2 Corinthians 10:6 - And having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled.

2 Corinthians 6:14 - Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?

James 1:4 - But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.

James 1:5 - If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

James 1:6 - But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed.

James 1:7 - For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord.

James 1:8 - A double minded man is unstable in all his ways.

Psalms 84:11 - For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.

1 Timothy 3:2 - A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach; Not given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre; but patient, not a brawler, not covetous; "One that ruleth well his own house, having his children in subjection with all gravity; (For if a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he take care of the church of God?) Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the devil.

Titus 2:11 - For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men,

Titus 2:12 - Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world;

Titus 2:13 - Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;

Titus 2:14 - Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.
